What is Dolly Parton's **Imagination Library Cork?**

Dolly Parton's Imagination Library is a book gifting programme for children aged 0-5. Each month a new, carefully selected, book will arrive by post in each child's name and be delivered directly to their home. There is no cost involved for the family.

Who is itfor?

All children from birth until their 5th birthday living in: Knocknaheeny, Hollyhill, Churchfield, Gurranabraher, Mahon, Carrigtwohill, Ashbourne House, Kinsale Road Accommodation Centre or registered with Let's Grow Together!

What do I need to do?

- 1. Be a resident of one of the above areas
- 2. Complete the attached registration form
- 3. Notify us any time the registered child's address changes.
- 4. Explore, share, read and enjoy the books with your child!

When will my child receive books?

8 to 10 weeks after you register each child, books will begin arriving by post and will continue each month until that child turns 5 or moves out of an eligible area.
